***The Polk Auction Race will be a 300-mile race with all racing lofts flying a minimum of 300 miles from Byron, Ga., with the alternate race station being Louisville, GA in case of inclement weather. Race station to be decided on the night of shipping by the handlers (Fliers). This race will be flown during the Polk Young Bird season, with the proposed shipping date being Wednesday, November 14th and racing Thursday, November 15th with the final date being set by the Race Committee. Breeders and owners of the auction birds do not have to be members of the Polk Racing Pigeon Club.

***85 % of the proceeds will go into the prize money pool after auction expenses. 15% of the gross proceeds will go to the Polk Club. The race will payout to 30 positions. The pool split will be: Breeders 40%, Fliers 30%, and Owners 30%. The first 10 birds will be brought to knock-off and auctioned off.

***Three (3) auctions will be held during the Old Bird series. Birds sold at the auction will not be transferable. The minimum bid of \$25.00 will be guaranteed by the breeder, with an additional \$5.00 fee for out of area birds. Birds sold at the auction are not replaceable. Special Polk Auction Bands will be sold at the auctions ONLY with a minimum Auction Bid of \$25.00 per band. Sixty (60) auction bands for 1st and 2nd auctions and thirty (30) auction bands for the 3rd, only a total of 150 auction bands to be auctioned off.

*****Payment of 50% of auction bill is due at the close of each auction-WITH NO EXCEPTIONS!** All auction money must be paid one week prior to the young bird race series. All cash payments will receive a receipt. Entry sheets are to be sent to the race director one month before the auction race. Polk and AU race rules will be followed.

***All flyers who are participating in the Polk Auction Race should have their clocks cleared before shipping and have knowledge of their own clocking system so they may assist someone else in entering their birds.
